

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

Our train-the-trainer programs allow you to become a Red Cross instructor and train others to save lives. To become an instructor, follow these steps:

1. Contact the American Red Cross Dallas Area Chapter and complete an Application for Authorization to Teach Form. (Note: Acceptance into an Instructor Course does not guarantee authorization to teach.) A current basic level course certificate for the course you are interested in teaching is recommended.
2. Take Fundamentals of Instructor Training. This four-hour course is a prerequisite to all Red Cross instructor specialty courses. It is designed to offer potential Red Cross instructors an opportunity to become familiar with the services of the American Red Cross as well as basic teaching techniques.
3. Take the Instructor Specialty Course.

After one has successfully completed the Full-Course (SFA/CPR(AIC)/AED), the class will move into the Instructor portion of the class. The Instructor Class includes skills to become an effective instructor, practice teaches to help you get comfortable with a classroom setting, and all the information and resources you will need to be a successful professionally trained American Red Cross Instructor. BABYSITTER'S INSTRUCTORS TRAINING

Babysitter's Instructors Course

Prerequisites

- Be at least 16 years of age on or before the final scheduled session of the instructor course.
- Possess a *Fundamentals of Instructor Training Certificate* issued within the last year or possess a current national *Health and Safety Services Instructor Authorization Certificate*.
- Successfully complete the instructor pre-course self-study and the pre-course session. This includes demonstrating competency in the pre-course skills.

Learning Objectives

- Expand on information from the American Red Cross Fundamentals of Instructor Training (FIT) course to teach the course, additional lessons and additional activities in the Babysitter's Training program.
- Demonstrate the characteristics required of an American Red Cross representative and role model.
- Teach courses in a manner that helps participants stay engaged in the learning process.
- Ensure participants' health and safety during training.
- Demonstrate skills at an appropriate level of performance.
- Maintain complete and accurate records and reports.
- Plan, organize and conduct the courses and presentations in the Babysitter's Training program in accordance with the requirements of the specific course or presentation they will be teaching, and evaluate participants.
- Monitor participants' practice and provide corrective feedback and encouragement consistent with the critical skill performance steps.
