

COURSES FOR PROFESSIONAL RESCUERS

American Red Cross professional rescuer courses are designed for people with a job-related duty to respond in an emergency, including nurses, law enforcement and EMS personnel, fire fighters, business and industry response teams, lifeguards, flight attendants, and others who must take action in emergency situations.

CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer / AED

The purpose of this course is to teach those with a duty to act (including professional rescuers and healthcare providers) the skills needed to respond appropriately to breathing and cardiac emergencies. This includes the use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) to care for a victim of cardiac arrest.

Participants who successfully complete the course have the choice of one of the following certificates:

- CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and the Healthcare Provider which is valid for 2 years
- CPR/AED for the Healthcare Provider which is valid for 2 years
- CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer which is valid for 2 years

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CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer (Challenge)

The purpose of the challenge course is to allow individuals who are comfortable with skills to test out without sitting through a formal class. Participants in this challenge do not have to be currently or previously certified in this class. Individuals who do not successfully complete both the written and skills test will need to enroll in the full course and will forfeit the challenge fee.
